This position is responsible for collaborating with the youth ministry team across all our campuses to continue the ministry momentum for youth with our youth and families from grades 6 to 12 for the spring and summer, including the Graduation celebration in mid-June. They will also be responsible for planning the fall events.

In this role you will:

- Work collaboratively with the Youth Pastor and youth staff in the execution of ministry.
- Equip and communicate with leaders for senior and junior high events.
- Plan and execute summer youth events in collaboration with youth staff.
- Promote summer events using social media, email and direct connections with leaders and students. Create graphics and event descriptions.
- Assist in planning and executing pre-determined youth events for year end and fall start up.
- Recruitment of leaders to assist with summer events.
- Work within an assigned budget.
- Other assignments as mutually agreed upon.
